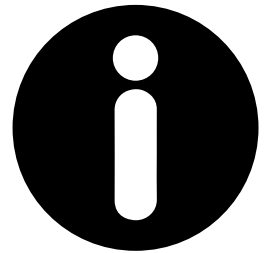

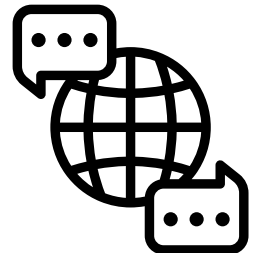
The official information website for refugees from Ukraine of the Federal Ministry of the Interior and Home Affairs, offers practical initial information on topics such as health, housing and work.

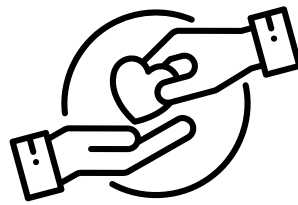
